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**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUPPLY OF FEED INGREDIENT W.E.F. 26-10-2020 to 31-3-2021.**

1. The tender has to be downloaded from the website of the University. In case of more than one tender submitted by a particular firm tender has to be submitted along with Indian postal Order or Demand Draft of **Rs.1,000/-** in the name of the Nanaji Deshmukh Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwa Vidyalaya, Assistant Registrar (General), Jabalpur containing separate envelopes and mention tender cost in block letter. Tender for each item separately must be submitted in sealed cover addressed to the undersigned by **Registered Post only** and with acknowledgement due so as to reach on or before **29-10-2020 up to 4:00 P.M.** The cover shall bear the address of the tenderer and super scribed with the words.

**TENDER FOR FEED INGRADIENT**

2. Tender shall be accompanied with the samples of each **item/ingredient which shall not be less than one kg** and shall be submitted in sealed bags bearing complete address, **Tel./Mob. No. of the tenderer and the description of the articles etc.** The good to be supplied after acceptance of the tender should commensurate with quality of the sample supplied by the tenderer. No tender shall ordinarily be accepted without sample and may be liable to be rejected. In exceptional cases, if otherwise satisfied, the Registrar, Nanaji Deshmukh Veterinary Science University (NDVSU), Jabalpur reserves the right to accept any tender even without sample.
3. **A.** The tender shall not be acceptable without the receipt of earnest money/security deposit in the shape of fixed deposit receipt (FDR) of **Rs. 75,000( Rs. Seventy Five Thousand only)** issued on any Nationalized Bank duly discharged in the name of "Nanaji Deshmukh Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwa Vidyalaya, Assistant Registrar (General), Jabalpur" which will be refunded after warranty period.  
**B. Envelope-A** will contain I.P.O/D.D. in shape of Tender Cost, Income Tax clearance certificate/ GST Certificate, Authorization/Manufacture certificate and other relevant documents. **Envelope-B** will contain Technical Bid. **Envelope-C** will contain Price Bid. **Envelope-D** will contain Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) as earnest money/ security deposit. **Envelope-E** will contain all the above four envelopes. All the envelopes should be properly sealed. The tender documents in **Envelope –E, A ,B, C & D** will be opened on **03-11-2020 at 11:00AM.**
4. The above security is taken for due performance of the contract as per provisions of the conditions mentioned in tender form. The same will be refunded on the expiry of the contract on successful completion of the supply with reference to specifications with proper supply and adjustment of any loss by way of purchasing the goods from other party / parties in case of dishonoring of the indent for supply and deliberate non supply.
5. Quantity of the items to be purchased will depend upon the requirement and their shall be no obligation to place order for any quantity of the item.
6. Tenders shall not be accepted without GST registration number of the firm.
7. All tenders must be accompanied by an Income Tax clearance certificate pertaining to the year 2019-20, assessment year 2020-2021 without which the tenders shall not be entertained or in exceptional case where the income tax department has given a certificate that the concerned firm has been newly started. Tenders will be accepted only from those dealers who pay regular income taxes. The party who are not capable of **investing at least Rs. 1,50,000/-** in the contract transaction need not to submit the tender.
8. No person or firm is permitted to submit more than one tender under different names.
9. The rates of tender shall not be altered by the tenderer during the contract under tender.
10. The competent authority (Registrar, NDVSU., Jabalpur) reserves the right of the accepting the tender in part or whole or distribution of the supply between one or more tenderer.
11. The submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read the terms and conditions of tender/contract and is fully aware of the scope and specification of the supplies to be made. He also must satisfy himself regarding the suitability and availability of the materials. The tenderer, who is not satisfied by our terms and conditions of the contract need not submit the tender.
12. The competent authority (Registrar, NDVSU, Jabalpur) reserves the right to increase, decrease or withdraw any item/items of supply during the contract under tender and the tender will be bound to comply without any claim for compensation.
13. The rates should be quoted separately for **F.O.R. Jabalpur, Mhow and Rewa**, inclusive of the charges and the cost of packing materials, which have to be borne by the tenderer. The weighment will be made on the weigh bridge of the farm before weighment committee. In case the farm weigh bridge is out of order the competent authority can direct a tenderer to get the

supply weighed from an approved weighing scale of any firm located or constitute a committee to do random sample weighing of a bag for final assessment of weight. The goods will be received only in working days between 9.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. the weighing committee/verification committee shall be competent to reject the supply if it is not as per the approved sample. The decision of the committee about quality and weight shall be final.

14. Latest GST return of last month along with quarterly deposit receipt must be provided, without which the tenders shall not be entertained or in exceptional case where the Goods & Service tax department has given a certificate that the concerned firm has been newly started.
15. The supply of material of order, should reach within 15 days to destination from the date of issue of supply order. This term should be followed strictly, otherwise the material will be purchased from the open market and the amount invested on the same will be deducted from the security deposit of tenderer.
16. All losses during transit i.e. breakage and shortage etc. will have to be supplied by the tenderer at his own Cost within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of such notices.
17. The undersigned does not bind himself to accept only the lowest rates.
18. The tenderer shall not submit whole or any portion of the contract to any party or parties, else the competent authority is free to cancel the contract and forfeit the security deposit.
19. The tenderer shall arrange to supply the commodities within a week from the date of receipt of the indent from the constituent units of this institution, unless otherwise indicated in the order of supply. In case the tenderer fails to execute the orders of supply within the stipulated period within 15 days, the competent authority (Registrar, NDVSU., Jabalpur) will forfeit the security amount and will be free to make alternate arrangement for purchase of goods. The difference in cost of purchase from open market on quotation basis and approved tender rate will be recovered from the security of the tenderer and / or bills pending for payments it will be decided by the Registrar. Further, defaulter firm, who has failed to supply the goods within prescribed period, these tenderer may not likely to be considered during next term or tender.
20. The payment of the bill will be arranged as early as possible from the date of receipt of the feed/ingredients and bill in respecting unit. The payment shall be made on net supply basis. The GST has to be shown separately.
21. Single rate should be offered for the entire tender period. Rates quoted for a shorter period are liable to be rejected.
22. The agreement bond should be executed on a non-judicial stamp paper worth **Rs. 100/-** not later than Two week by the successful tenderer. In the event of failure on the part of any successful tenderer to execute the agreement bond on non judicial stamp paper within the prescribed time limit, "Registrar, NDVSU" Jabalpur will be competent to forfeit the security deposit of such successful tenderer.
23. In case of any dispute arising out of this contract the arbitration power rests with the Vice-Chancellor, NDVSU, Jabalpur whose decision will be final to both the parties.
24. Tenders once submitted by the tenderer cannot be withdrawn by the tenderer.
25. Tenderer has to write clearly the name, address, and telephone number of the firm.
26. Name of commodities, on which the tenderer deal and its photocopy, the photocopy of license issued by Nagar Nigam or Government office for its business Original license will have to be produced within a week for verification if it is approved.
27. Photocopy of license from Controller Food and Civil Supplied if the tenderer deal in food and food ingredients (original will have to be produced for verification with a week, if the tender is approved).

29. The payment will be made to the contractor/ supplier after deducting Income Tax as per rule.
30. Firm will be responsible to deposit GST amount to the concerned office. In case of default, institute will not be responsible. Any irregularity in this regard will be the fault of firm and he has to face legal implications.
31. The supplier should mention the bank details like, Name of the bank, Account No. and IFSC Code of the firm in their bills for digital transaction.
32. Please quote the rates in Indian Currency.
