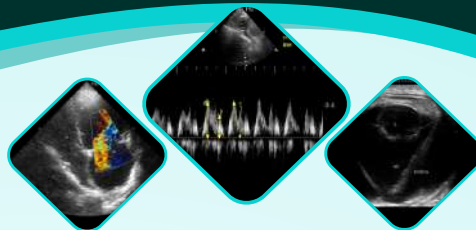
About the Host Institute

Nanaji Deshmukh Veterinary Science University, Jabalpur was established on 3rd November, 2009. It comprises of three Veterinary Colleges located in Jabalpur, Mhow and Rewa, along with School of Wildlife Forensic and Health, Animal Biotechnology Centre, College of Fishery Science and five Veterinary Polytechnic Colleges offering undergraduate, postgraduate and diploma courses.

The college was inaugurated on 8th July, 1948 by Shri Jaisamdes Doulatram, the then Food and Agricultural Minister, Government of India. Dr. M.Y. Mangrulkar was the founder Principal of the college. In 1964, this institute became one of the eight constituent colleges of newly established Jawaharlal Nehru Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur. The college is currently engaged in teaching, research, extension and clinical activities catering the needs of students, veterinarians, farmers and pet owners.

The Department of Veterinary Surgery and Radiology was established in the year 1952 and over the years has developed into one of the best components of the College. The department caters its specialized services all over the state. It has advanced diagnostic imaging facilities including CT scan, 80 kW X-ray machine, CR System, Ultrasound, Echocardiography, Colour Doppler and Pulse Wave Doppler along with Ophthalmic, Orthopaedic, Physiotherapy and Laparoscopy/Gastroscopy unit. A pioneering Prosthetic Limb Fitting Unit — the first of its kind in any Indian Veterinary institution dedicated exclusively to animal care is going to be inaugurated soon. This specialized unit focuses on designing and crafting artificial limbs for amputee animals, utilizing advanced orthotic materials and a state-of-the-art artificial limb moulding oven and 3-D printer.





About Jabalpur

Jabalpur, "The Sanskardhani or Cultural capital", is known for its world famous marble rocks, situated on the bank of River Narmada in the state of Madhya Pradesh, India. It is one of the largest cantonments in India that houses the army headquarters of five states. Some of the famous places to visit are Dhuandhar Falls Bhedaghat, Bargi Dam, Kachnar Temple, Pisanhari Jain Teerth, Gwarighat Gurudwara, Madan Mahal Fort, Balancing rock etc. Other nearby excursion sites include; Pench Tiger Reserve (160 km), Kanha National Park (167 km), Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve (170 km), Pachmarhi (200 km) and Khajuraho (250 km). The weather in the month of February will be pleasant to moderately cold with the temperature fluctuating between 14-28 °C. Light woollen clothes in morning and evening may be required.

How to Reach Jabalpur

The city is well connected by air, rail and road routes from main cities of India. The nearest airport is Dumna Airport (14 Km). Veterinary College, Jabalpur is at walking distance (0.5 Km) from the Jabalpur railway station.

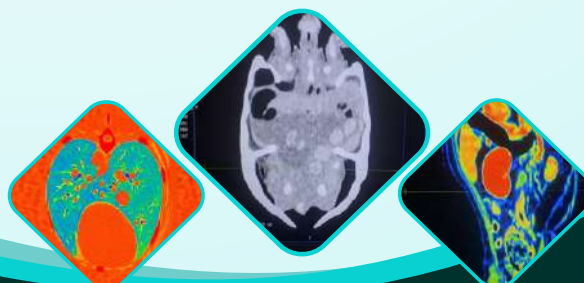

Submission of abstracts: Abstracts on original research/ clinical work are invited for different scientific sessions. The abstracts highlighting the presenting author, must reach the Organizing Secretary on or before **December 31, 2025** by e-mail **isvsjabalpur@gmail.com**. The mode of presentation of paper as oral/poster will be communicated in the letter of acceptance after screening by the technical committee. It will be mandatory on the part of presenter to register him/her for the symposium well in advance. Oral presentation by power point and poster should be informative and self-explanatory. Single case reports will only be considered for the poster session. **One presenter can send maximum of two abstracts.**
