4. You are requested to kindly circulate the Call for Entries information among the field offices and institutes also if any. Please showcase the enclosed poster on the notice board.

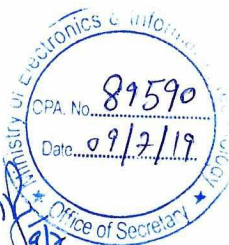

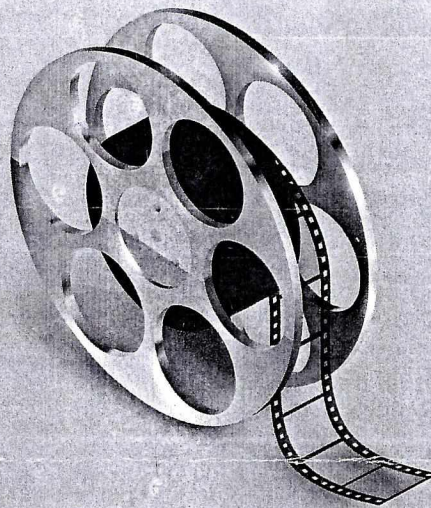
